## Science Setu Program Report

National Institute of Immunology (NII) conducted an online lecture program for the undergraduate students of Miranda House, Univeristy of Delhi on 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 under the Science Setu program to commemorate 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava/75<sup>th</sup> Year of Independence Celebration. Dr Nimesh Gupta, Head of Virus Immunology, Scientist, NII Lab took the lecture on the topic 'A deep dive into the Immunology of COVID-19 vaccine'. In his talk he spoke about the fundamentals of vaccine immunology and the current immunological understanding of the COVID-19 Vaccine.

The talk covered the fundamentals of vaccine immunology and the current understanding of the protection conferred by COVID-19 vaccines against recently circulating virus variants. The lecture also covered the details about recent available COVID-19 vaccines, their probable mechanism of action and potential in protecting against the recently circulating variants of concerns.

The program was followed up by a questions and answers session where students participated enthusiastically. They asked questions related to vaccines, which comprises of 'frequently asked questions' too. The program was well appreciated by the student community.
